FHF concludes a training workshops entitled Project-Based Learning (PBL)

On Monday the fifth of August 2024, the Faisal Husseini Foundation concluded its workshops for social studies teachers on Project-Based Learning (PBL).

PBL is one of the most effective methods for connecting theoretical learning with practical application, making students more engaged and involved in the educational process.





At its core, PBL involves selecting projects that meet functional needs while also achieving educational goals required by the curriculum, for example. Students and teachers become partners in both the production journey and the learning journey. PBL enhances critical and creative thinking by developing problem-solving skills in students and fostering innovative solutions. It encourages teamwork, which enhances collaboration and communication skills. Additionally, students do not just receive information passively; they actively participate in research, planning, and implementation.

The training was conducted for social studies teachers by Mr. Wasim Al-Kurdi at the Faisal Husseini Foundation's headquarters as part of the project to improve the quality of learning in schools in Jerusalem, funded by the Arab Fund for Economic and Social Development and implemented by the foundation.
